Fit-out (Concept/Prototype Schemes)

New concepts are essential for the retail sector, but can be challenging. Bridgford Interiors succeeded in translating an American concept to Kensington High Street.

Summary of Sector

- By its very nature the retail sector needs to continuously evolve to attract new and retain existing customers.
- New concepts or prototypes are the precursor to a greater programme of works - if the prototype trades successfully and meets the clients objectives it is likely to be rolled out through the brand.
- is likely to be rolled out through the brand.
 Prototype work is historically subject to change mid programme to amend specification or design to accommodate the latest requirements.
- Costs are higher due to these changes that are inevitable it is however far cheaper to trial concepts in one store than to install the wrong feature across a whole chain.
- Prototype stores can be used to trial a number of different specifications and to allow for value engineering in advance of a main programme.
- At this stage of development the fit-out contractors input is vital to ensure buildability of any future schemes.
