A small exclusive men's store on a single trading floor with an all wood finish throughout. 38 Lamb's Conduit is primarily a shirt shop and offers services such as monogramming, customised stitching and buttons and a complimentary delivery service.

Rather than leaving the external temporary hoarding blank whilst works continued inside, British artist Hugo Guinness was enlisted to illustrate "sketches of lambs doing various activities, such as riding bicycles and playing cricket".
