Mr Pink was an 18th century London tailor who designed the iconic hunting coat worn by Masters of Foxhounds, whippers-in, huntsmen and other hunt staff.

The coat was made of scarlet cloth but was always referred to as PINK, in honour of its originator.

The project entailed the removal of existing and the provision of new floors, ceilings, lighting and free standing display fixtures whilst maintaining the integrity of the listed arch structure all in the confines of a bustling international railway station!
